- If your puppy shows fear show your puppy something he or she already likes and provide a happy distance
- Sounds, scents, movements are all new too!

Puppy Play Rules

When a new puppy arrives in our **FREE Puppy Play**

- Go to your puppy and take collar with "Gotcha" and collar grab then treat.
- 2. Pick up or hold your puppy as the new puppy arrives in class.
- Allow new puppy to explore the room while you pet your puppy.
- Trainer will release pups to play one at a time to not overwhelm the new puppy.

When leaving Puppy Play

Leash or carry your puppy out of the room. Take turns.

Store Scavenger Hunt

Enjoy an in-store adventure.

- 1. Use a flat collar with six foot lead or harness.
- 2. Let puppy explore the store.
- 3. If your puppy piddles we have clean up gear!

- Smelling the dog food and treats.

- Toy aisle to pick a new toy.
- Sniffing the cat & bird area.
- Picking out a few bulk treats, bag and purchase a few.
